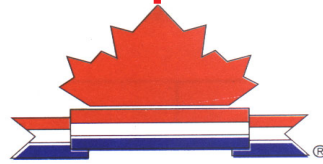


Holland Liberation Tour 2012

Plus Vimy Memorial, Arras & Paris

Tour Dates: April 30 - May 9



Welcome Again Veterans

Welcome Again Veterans Foundation is pleased to welcome you to Holland for the 67th Anniversary of Holland's liberation. The tour departs on April 30, 2012 and is open to everyone. Accommodations are in a hotel in Deventer, but veterans, their travelling companion and immediate family members are invited to



stay with a host family. For those eligible to stay with a host family, a price reduction will apply. Added features on this tour include a visit to the new Information Centre at Holten Canadian War Cemetery and a visit to the Vimy Memorial with an overnight in Arras followed by a 2 night stay in Paris.

Holland Liberation Program 2012

April 30

Depart from Toronto via overnight flight to Amsterdam. Dinner served onboard.

May 1

Arrival in Amsterdam. Enjoy a special welcome, then transfer to the host town of Deventer – host family or hotel. Evening reception followed by dinner. B/L/D

May 2

Full day tour to typical Dutch places including a wooden shoe factory, Ootmarsum and De Lutte with "koffietafel" lunch. Return to Deventer for dinner. B/L/D

May 3

Half day sightseeing tour of Deventer and surrounding area, including Olst. B/L/D

May 4

Commemorative service at Holten Canadian War Cemetery, followed by a tour of the new Information Centre. Afterward lunch in Bathman. Return to Deventer. B/L/D

May 5

National Liberation Day and Wageningen Parade. Evening farewell party in Deventer. B/L/D

May 6

Say goodbye to your wonderful hosts and

depart for Arras, France, with a visit to the Vimy Memorial. Overnight in Arras. B/D

May 7

Depart for Paris and enjoy a half day sightseeing tour of this beautiful "City of Lights". Overnight in Paris. B/D

May 8

You have a full day to explore, shop and enjoy Paris on your own. Overnight in Paris. B/D

May 9

Late morning transfer to the airport for the return flight to Toronto. B

Price: \$2475pp From Toronto (Single Supplement \$675)

PRICE REDUCTION FOR VETERANS - \$450pp

Veterans (and a travel companion), spouses of veterans and those who have a family member buried in Holland have the option to stay with a host family while in Deventer. If you are eligible to stay with a host family, your price is reduced by \$450pp. The Booking Form has a section that needs to be completed for this to apply.

Liberation 2012 Tour flight will only depart from Toronto. Verstraete Travel can arrange connection flights to Toronto from other Canadian cities upon request as indicated on the Booking Form.

Price Includes:

- Round trip airfare from Toronto.
- Meals as shown in the program B=Breakfast, L=Lunch, D=Dinner
- Coach transfers from airport to your host town.
- Accommodations with your host family or at the hotel.
- All tours as shown in the program

Price does NOT Include:

- Airport taxes, security fees, fuel surcharges (\$475pp)
- Travel insurance (the Booking Form will include all details on the insurance options)
- All items of a personal nature such as drinks, souvenirs etc.

NOTE: All arrangements are made in association with Welcome Again Veterans. All events are subject to final confirmation and they reserve the right to make changes and adjustments.

2012 GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

BOOKING PROCEDURE:

DEPOSIT:

\$700.00 per person. The deposit is non-refundable and due at time of booking.

Your insurance premium is also due at this time.

PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD:

There is a \$75 pp surcharge for payment by credit card.

FORM OF PAYMENT:

Cheque - payable to Verstraete Travel & Cruises,
Credit Card - provide card details on booking form.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

Deposit is due at time of booking with your selected insurance premium.
Final Payment Due: February 15, 2012

BOOKING DEADLINE:

All reservations are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Since we are limiting the number of participants, we recommend that you book as soon as possible.

INSURANCE:

We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation or all-inclusive insurance. The rates are outlined on the Booking Form.

PASSPORTS:

It is your responsibility to make sure that you have a **valid passport**. It must be valid for at least 6 months after your departure date. Canadian passport holders do not need a visa. If you are travelling with a non-Canadian passport it is your responsibility to inform our staff so that they can advise you of entry requirements.

PRICING:

All prices are based on minimum group size, current exchange rates and supplier quotations. In the event that significant changes take place due to circumstances beyond our control, we reserve the right to adjust the prices.

CANCELLATION:

If you have to cancel, you must inform Verstraete Travel in writing. The cancellation penalty is based on the date your cancellation is received. Cancellation penalties are shown in the chart below:

- Deposit is non-refundable.
- 6 months - 2 months prior to departure - 50%,
- 2 months or less prior to departure - 100%

FINAL ITINERARY & TRAVEL DETAILS:

It is anticipated that all the final details will be included in the travel documents and distributed 21 days before departure. Due to the nature of the tour program we reserve the right to make changes and substitutions wherever necessary.

REFUNDS:

Refund requests must be received in writing within 60 days of the date of the cause of cancellation. Please allow four to six weeks for processing.

UNUSED TOUR ARRANGEMENTS:

Portions of tour arrangements, or any other service or feature of the package which are not used are neither refundable nor exchangeable.

RESPONSIBILITY:
